Lieutenant Colonel James S. Shutt, US Army, Retired

Colonel Shutt is the Deputy for Operations, 4th Brigade ROTC, US Army Cadet Command, Fort Bragg, North Carolina. He served 24 years on active duty as an Infantry Officer retiring in 2007. He has worked with the United States Army Cadet Command for 18 years; four as Professor of Military Science at Southern Illinois University, Carbondale, Illinois; two as Brigade Executive Officer, 4th Brigade; and, two as Senior Army Instructor (JROTC) at Southern Lee High School, Sanford, North Carolina. He has been the Brigade's Deputy as an Army civilian since November 2008.

Colonel Shutt was commissioned in May 1983 as a Distinguished Military Graduate from Murray State University, Kentucky. He has served in a variety of command and staff assignments both stateside and overseas. His past assignments included: Rifle Platoon Leader, 82d Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, North Carolina; Ranger Instructor, 1st Ranger Company, Eglin Air Force Base, Florida; Observer-Controller, National Training Center, California; Battalion Operations Officer, 25th Infantry Division, Schofield Barracks, Hawaii; and, Deputy Brigade Commander, Basic Combat Training Brigade, Fort Benning, Georgia.

He is a graduate of the Infantry Officer's Basic and Advanced Courses, the Combined Arms and Services Staff School, and Command and General Staff College (both Army and Air Force). He holds a Bachelor of Science in Agriculture degree from Murray State University, Kentucky; a Master's in Public Administration degree from Golden Gate University, California; and, a Master's in Military Operational Arts and Science degree from the US Air Force Air War College, Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama.

Colonel Shutt's awards and decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal (5 OLC), Army Commendation Medal (1 OLC), Army Achievement Medal (2 OLC), Master Parachutist's Badge, Ranger Tab, and the Expert Infantryman's Badge.

He and his wife Sally reside in Wade, North Carolina. Sally is an Assistant County Manager for Cumberland County North Carolina. Their youngest daughter is a high school English teacher in Plano Texas; their oldest daughter is an Army Captain, Doctor of Physical Therapy, posted at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington.
